Staff and volunteers work one-on-one with our service members, veterans, and military familiesproviding ongoing support for as long as legitimate needs require. Experienced at anticipating needs, our case managers often introduce new programs

assistance and lifetime support to our nation's critically wounded, ill, and injured service

to further assist service members and military families throughout the journey to recovery and transition back into their communities. The Fund can process, on average, over 130 grant requests each day. We typically deliver assistance within 24-48 hours of receiving an emergency request, and within a week for non-urgent cases.

NEW YORK POLICE & FIRE The New York Police and Fire Widows' and Children's Benefit Fund's mission is to support the families of New York City Police Officers, Firefighters, Port Authority Police, and EMS Personnel who have been killed in the line of duty. When these brave men and women make the ultimate sacrifice to protect our city, we believe it is our civic duty to support the families these heroes have left behind. The New York Police and Fire Widows' and Children's Benefit Fund currently provides financial assistance, hosts special gatherings,

and offers a network of support to approximately 600 families. Each year, they distribute
