Dr. Jane Morton has had a fulfilling career as a general pediatrician, with a long-standing interest in breastfeeding. She has conducted research on human milk and breastfeeding and has designed and implemented breastfeeding curriculums, novel practice changes and policies. She produced award winning videos, including, "A Premie Needs His Mother: Breastfeeding a Premature Baby", "Making Enough Milk, the Key to Successful Breastfeeding" and "A Mother's Touch, Breastfeeding in the First Hour". She designed an educational website for expectant mothers with the goal of preventing common breastfeeding problems, [www.firstdroplets.com](http://www.firstdroplets.com). As an executive board member of both the Academy of Breastfeeding Medicine and the American Academy of Pediatrics Section on Breastfeeding, she enjoyed working to enlarge the footprint of breastfeeding, both nationally and internationally. Dr. Morton has designed a nationally recognized educational program and has co-authored the book *Best Medicine: Human Milk in the NICU*. She teaches at Stanford where she is an Adjunct Clinical Professor of Pediatrics, Emerita.
