Through care package distributions, meal programs, and direct outreach, we mobilize volunteers to deliver essential esupplies to support those in need

What We Do

Chapter Development

- -National leadership supports high school students in launching their own OGS chapters

02 Volunteer Mobilization

- -Deploy OGS members to local organizations (e.g., soup kitchens, shelters)

- -Host fundraising events to support our mission
- -Use funds to supply chapters and fund care package drives

How to Start a Chapter (3 Easy Steps)

- 2. Establish Your Chapter → OGS leadership will guide you through the setup process, connect you with other chapters, and support you as you get registered with your school administration as an official club/entity
- 3. Launch Your First Project → Whether it's a care package drive or partnering with a shelter, we'll help you kick off strong



How Supplies Work

OGS provides a clear, structured system to make sure every chapter has the resources they need to succeed

1. Supply Access

 After registering as an official club, chapter presidents gain access to the OGS Supply Order Form. Student leaders can request materials (backpacks, hygiene kits, socks, etc.), and OGS ships supplies directly. Funds are managed centrally, so chapters don't have to handle money.

2. Fundraising & Growth

 Once established, chapters may host local fundraisers to expand their impact. The official OGS Venmo will be used at your fundraisers to collect donations, which are reported back to OGS for accountability. These funds can then be used to order additional supplies through our system or support local service partnerships.
