The Institute invites applications for a full-time Archivist to support the preservation and accessibility of the organization's historical collections. This position focuses on Environmental Justice initiatives and New Mexico grassroots activism, including efforts that led to the creation of the first healthcare clinics in the state.

The Archivist will play a key role in retrieving, managing, organizing, and preserving archival materials while assisting to ensuring their long-term accessibility for research, education, and public engagement. This is a three-year appointment.
