

COACH ANGGY

Coach Anggy is a former member of the Indonesian national badminton team with an extensive international coaching career. Prior to coaching in the United States, he held key coaching roles in Indonesia, the Philippines, and Peru.

In the Philippines, he contributed to the national team program and collaborated with Senior Coach Rexy Mainaky, an Olympic gold medalist in men's doubles from Indonesia. In Peru, he was entrusted with leading both a prominent local club and the national team training program, reflecting the high level of confidence placed in his expertise and leadership.

He is an accomplished badminton coach with a proven track record of developing elite athletes across several countries. He coached a player to reach World No. 115 in the BWF rankings and guided the Philippines' top-ranked women's singles player in 2017. In Peru, he made history by leading the national team to its first-ever all-Peruvian women's singles final at the 2021 Pan American Junior Championships. He was honored as "Best Coach in Peru" in 2021, 2023, and 2024. His leadership roles include Head Coach at CLTE Badminton Peru and coaching positions with the Peruvian national team, Team Prima Badminton Club in the Philippines, and Semen Gresik Badminton Club in Indonesia. He has also worked alongside Indonesian Olympic gold medalist Rexy Mainaky, bringing valuable international insight to his coaching.
