











- Severe drought can create political instability
- Crop failure and ensuing high food prices can fuel conflict





Countries with very high levels of peace achieved on average over four times higher per capita GDP growth compared to the least peaceful countries.



| GDP | Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is the measurement of the economic health of a country. |
|-------------------|--|
| WAR | GDP on average falls 30% and inflation increases by 15% |
| CLIMATE CHANGE | 2 degrees C rise before 2100 is projected to lead to a decline in GDP of between 30 and 50 % |


