Scholarship Value \$5000 (Five Thousand Dollars)

Scholarship Criteria:

- Female
- Of Italian descent
- Currently in Grade 12
- Minimum 75% overall average
- Exemplary citizens that demonstrated excellence in athletics, academics, leadership, and community involvement. Scoring will be as follows:
 - 35% to athletic ability and performance.
 - 30% to scholastic achievement. The nominee's grade 12 marks (first term final marks plus second term midterm marks) will be used. In the event of a tie, grade 10 and 11 marks will be used.
 - 15% to citizenship, leadership, sportsmanship and community involvement.
 - 20% to personal response.
- Registered in a post-secondary program for September 2026 (proof of enrollment letter and tuition payment required by October 1, 2026)
- Able to attend the CISDA Celebration Dinner on Oct 23, 2026. A designate may attend if recipient is away for post-secondary studies.

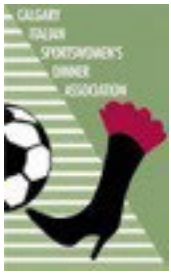

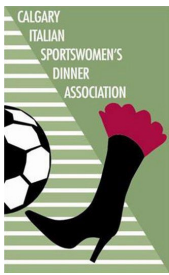

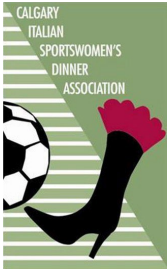
