

Meeting Highlights from March 2022

Church Council met on March 22, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. Minutes were reviewed and approved from the February meeting.

Pastor's Report: Pastor mentioned that Christmas 2022 falls on a Sunday this year and that congregation should start thinking about holiday services. After Pentecost, Rev. Pittman would like to review the flow of service.

Financial: Discussion regarding accounts payable reporting and to have that show accurate income and spending of everyday operations but also separately show contributions and operating expenses. Payments are being made monthly to Pension Boards and Rev. Pittman will complete necessary paperwork by end of March. United Church Funds will be invited to next Council meeting to discuss funds in detail.

Building & Grounds: Dwight Kraus reported that the road was grated in time for the Green Eggs and Ham breakfast. He also reported he has received bids to replace the front doors of the church. A bid from Dean's Cabinetry in Farmington has been approved by Council to have them build new doors to replicate the current ones.

Search Committee: The committee has the church profile ready to go out the first of April.

Endowment: Warren Stuckmeyer reported that the Endowment Committee extended the application time for funds to be requested. They will continue to accept applications until April for the May meeting.

Board of Christian Education: Connie Stuckmeyer requested that the Easter Breakfast be moved from Easter Sunday to Palm Sunday service and Council approved this calendar change.

Board of Elders: The BOE reported that the children will again go to the front of the church for the Children's Message every Sunday. The decision was also made that the Elders will no longer dismiss by rows after church, people want to socialize now on their way out. Council approved BOE overseeing the Zoom setup.

New Business: A motion was made and approved to add Barb Allen as a signer on the St. Luke's MWBank checking account and remove Becky Hollerbach. The All-Board Meeting will be held on May 17th to coincide with the May Council Meeting. The minutes from the Annual Meeting will be reviewed, edited, and retyped by Yvonne to include recommended corrections.

Easter Lillies/Memorials: Fifteen (15) lilies have been ordered to decorate the church for Easter. Inserts will be included each Sunday with bulletins for Memorials/Honors.

The Board of Elders met on March 8, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. Minutes were reviewed and approved from the February meeting.

Worship: Things are going fine. Barb Lovera will be doing further alterations to the white altar cloths to make them fit better.

Elders Calendar: The BOE yearly calendar has been updated and distributed to the Board of Elders. BOCE requested that BOE take over some events such as the Hayride and Bingo and BOE has declined that offer/ request.

Lenten Services: Jess will be working with Pastor Josh to discuss what type of service he would prefer and if there are any special considerations. Palm Sunday (4/10) at 9am; Good Friday (4/15) at 7pm and Easter Sunday (4/17) at 9am.

Communion: Discussion was had as to when church could return to traditional distribution of Communion elements, and it was decided to wait until after the summer.

Highlights from March 2022

The Board of Christian Education met on March 1, 2022, at 6:30 p.m. Minutes were reviewed and approved from the January meeting.

Sunday School: Connie will select and begin practicing music for kids to sing Palm Sunday during worship. There was some discussion on how to return to offering coffee/donuts/etc following worship or Sunday School. This discussion was tabled for now.

Confirmation: Students have finished their Spiritual autobiographies and are now diving into their Statements of Faith. BOCE will review how to incorporate the field trips for the Confirmation class either in person or virtual in the next class 2023/2024.

1st Quarter Mission: All 2022 will remain the same as last year with Pony Bird being 1st quarter. Camp MoVal will be reorganizing and reopening again. We will keep this in mind for the future.

Green Eggs & Ham Breakfast: Planning for fifty people to attend. Flyers have been posted and handed out at Sunday School.

Palm Sunday Breakfast: Connie will meet with the parents of the confirmands on Sunday 3/20 to discuss options for Palm Sunday Breakfast and to divide responsibilities. There will also be a bake/bakeless sale by the ladies in Women's Guild and Evening Circle.

Palm Cross Making/Easter Egg Hunt: Saturday, April 9th. Confirmands will be asked to help with the Easter Egg Hunt and will need one volunteer to dress up in costume as our "special guest." We will also invite Pat/John Sieving to help instruct them on making Palm Crosses. Tricia has ordered palms. Plans were made and in place for a successful morning.

Rummage Sale: Sale will take place on the church parking lot on June 4th (rain date June 11th). Sarah will make a signup sheet and flyer. This will be a fundraiser for BOCE with funds supporting the church youth. This will be advertised in the Leader free section and the radio. Flyer will be emailed to local churches.

Falling for Jesus Festival: The activity originally planned for October 23rd has been changed to "Falling for Jesus Festival" which will include fall themed games, competitions and activities following Sunday School. Some ideas provided were shuffleboard, ping pong, cornhole, bobbing for donuts, corn kernel shucking. More discussion to follow. Kids will be encouraged to bring friends to worship, Sunday School, and the festival.

Event Sponsors: Connie spoke with Jess McLard regarding the proposal to have the Board of Elders sponsor the Bingo and Hayride/Bonfire for 2022. The Elders declined as they do not want prescheduled activities/annual events at this time. They will be focusing on worship, occasional "popup" events and helping with activities such as Rally Day/All Church Picnic. The Bonfire/Hayride and Bingo have been removed from the 2022 Events Calendar.
