

Meeting Highlights from November 2021

<u>Pastor:</u> Pastor was not in attendance due to illness. Pastor Josh will be on vacation December December 25th through January 1st. There will be a Guest Pastor on Sunday, December 26th

<u>Financial</u>: Sandy Arnold reviewed the Treasurer's report and monthly financials. The accounts were reviewed. Sandy is organizing the "funds" setup in the accounting system. Discussion was had regarding adding an additional person to the Board to assist Sandy. Linda provided the Financial Secretary report and advised the 2022 giving envelopes have been ordered.

<u>Search Committee</u>: Jess McLard addressed Council with questions from the Committee. Jess spoke about Elders and getting a letter out for making inactive members "affiliates" and provided a list for review. Also, it was discussed that we need to make another Bylaw revision to make Inactive members "affiliates" and drop the word "member." There are approximately 60 people to receive a letter. Council approved the list and letter.

<u>Building & Grounds:</u> The fire suppression system will require a new nitrogen cartridge when inspected in January 2022. The cost has been added into the 2022 budget. Dwight arranged for the security guys to meet with a group and setup access to the camera system. Bob & Linda Schrepel have access to rewind recordings from the cameras and Tricia is setup as a user but cannot rewind. Dwight is talking with an Amish company to make wood doors for the church. Peggy called Dwight about some kids on bikes and skateboards playing on the front steps of the church but by the time Dwight got onsite, it was dark, and they were gone.

Endowment: Announcement of endowment funds being available has been included in the Beacon, Bulletin, and news to the church committees.

New Business: Employee Care and Review Board meeting with Tricia on Monday the 22nd and will meet with Pastor after that. The 2022 Budget report initial draft was discussed, and vote will be taken at the December meeting. Discussed the Worker's Compensation Insurance Renewal and it was reviewed and approved.

Annual Congregational Meeting: Annual Meeting will be held Sunday, January 16th at 2 p.m.

Highlights from November 2021

The Board of Elders met on November 9th, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. Minutes were reviewed and approved from the October meeting.

Worship: Things continue to go well. While Kay Moss is out of town, someone else will be updating the altar cloths and filling the candles.

Ushers: Things are going well. Because we are now passing the offering plate, starting with the December usher schedule, a third Usher will be added to each service.

Visitor Care: In September we had ten (10) visitors and in October we had two (2) visitors.

Confirmation Class: Things are going well with the new class of seven members who meet with Pastor Joshua on Sunday right after church. They have started doing the scripture reading each Sunday.

Thanksgiving: There will be no Thanksgiving Eve Worship Service this year.

2021 Christmas Schedule: The Church will be decorated for Christmas / Advent Season on Sunday, November 28th following service and pizza lunch will be provided. On Sunday, December 19^{th,} Worship Service will be a Christmas Carol Hymn Sing. On Friday, December 24th, there will be a Christmas Eve service at 7 p.m. with communion. The format for the service will be lessons and carols where a Christmas themed scripture is read then a carol sung that applies to the scripture. There will be NO Christmas Day service on Saturday, December 25th. Pastor Josh will be out of town on Sunday, December 26th and a Guest Pastor will do the service. BOE to work with Church Secretary on the Christmas Fund Special Offering envelope procedure.

Membership Task Force: Required administrative changes to Church Windows database is in the works. Task force is working with the Church Secretary to get these changes made. The task force has authorized a rough draft of a letter to be sent to members who are not participating in the life of the church. Elders reviewed the letter and recommended a few minor changes before it is sent to Church Council for approval. A list of inactive members will accompany the letter.

2022 Congregational Meeting: BOE has been tasked with providing a recommended budget. This is something new for Elders and will require some thought as to what it should contain.
