Meeting Minutes from February 16, 2021

The Church Council met on Tuesday, February 16th for their regularly scheduled meeting.

<u>Welcome New Members</u>: Council welcomed Barb Allen and Warren Stuckmeyer. Barb Allen is the new VP and Warren will represent Burgess Cemetery. Planning a proper "installment" of all new committee officers, this has not happened yet since all committees had not met and completed new role elections.

Executive Committee: It has been approved by Council and BOE to begin ringing the bell during Sunday service. The bell ringer must be seated in the balcony for service. Evening Circle has been approved to resume their monthly meetings in Fellowship Hall, following safety protocols. Banking details have been changed over to new officers.

Church Office: Becky and Greg completed Tricia's annual review on January 28th.

Parsonage / Renters: Harold and Peggy, Parsonage renters requested parking for a purchased camper on the back of the church lot and Council approved.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Pittman discussed sound system / webcam needs for Virtual Sunday services. Greg McLard purchased a few items to implement to get better sound without using multiple laptops. Pastor has received great feedback about services thus far.

<u>Pastoral Search Committee</u>: Search Committee continues to need more volunteers, looking for 7-9 people to serve, different age groups and both men and women.

<u>Building and Grounds Committee</u>: Lighting has been ordered for the Sanctuary. Dwight will follow up with the electrician for install once the supplies arrive. Dwight has had two appointments with the Sanctuary door contractor but was "stood up" both times.

Worship: Reviewed how worship services are going every Sunday. The Zoom meeting/hybrid in-person worship services are going well. There continues to be some sound issues for those not in the Sanctuary and additional work on the sound system is requested. Greg and Rev. Pittman will review and offer suggestions.

<u>Church Access</u>: Review who needs keys for the church and can we get them returned from others who no longer need access.

Building Usage Request: Dave Pippin inquired about a member using the Church garage for an online auction pickup location. These items are already sold and paid for, just looking for a mutual place for pickup. Dave stated the items would be setup on Friday and picked up Saturday. More information was requested, and this topic was tabled for discussion at the next meeting.

Sunday School: Sarah Saputo submitted letter to Church Council requesting that Sunday School be reopened, this will be discussed at an upcoming All Board Meeting.

Worship: In-person worship is going good. At the upcoming "All Board' meeting, plans call for discussion regarding the existing in-person COVID protocol and restrictions.

Ushers: Things are going smoothly with in-person worship services. Need to clarify with ushers that they are responsible for lighting the altar candles at the beginning of the service and extinguishing them at the end of the service.

Nursery care: At this time, no nursery care is being provided.

Communion: For the foreseeable future, Reverend Pittman will be doing all services virtual. When Communion is scheduled, only the wine chalice and cup will be placed on the altar as symbols. Funerals/Memorial Services: At this time, it is preferred funerals be held at a funeral home.

Old Business: Rev. Pittman is working on solutions to address the poor audio quality for the members attending Sunday services virtually.

2021 Lenten Mission: The BOE 2021 Lenten Mission will be PonyBird.

Easter Season: Planning to coordinate plans with Rev. Pittman for Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday, and Confirmation Sunday services.

Food Drive: Food drive will run the month of March. Donations will be given to local food pantries.

Other Items: All Elders were given a copy of the "Elder Responsibility" to review and update, as needed. Member Care strategies will be discussed at the March meeting. Jess will update the Elder's funeral usher volunteer list. Some members are requesting to stand during parts of Service, needs to be coordinated with Pastor Pittman. Brenda Day will also speak to Rev. Pittman regarding breaking bread and pouring of wine for communion services. Kay Moss is going to work to get the floral arrangements for services updated and improved.

Meeting Minutes from February 2, 2021

The Board of Christian Education met on Tuesday, February 2nd for their regularly scheduled meeting. Minutes from previous meeting found in good order.

2021 Reorganization: Connie Stuckmeyer, Chairperson; Chrissy Kraus, Secretary; Kathy Porter, Church Council Rep.; Kayla Bailey, Superintendent Sunday School; Brenda Farson, Assistant Superintendent Sunday School.

Sunday School: Connie began recording YouTube videos for the Children's Message again. Rev. Pittman suggested keeping the video between 5-8 minutes so that they can be used in worship service for the Children's Sermon. These will continue to be sent out and posted on the website and Facebook page by Tricia also. The children's heart artwork was used to decorate the Sanctuary and as a slideshow on Valentine's Day.

Church Council: As of January 31, 2021, we are ringing the Church bell during service again.

Confirmation: Rev. Pittman suggested that Confirmation Sunday be during worship service with the congregation in attendance. Chris will confirm a schedule with the students and families regarding expectations and events. Engraved bibles will be ordered for Confirmands this year. Will return to giving the engraved bibles to students going into 3rd grade and eliminate the Action Bible that we were giving the 1st graders.

Missions: Designated mission for each quarter: PonyBird, Crisis Nursery, Brenden's Backpack and Camp Mo-Val. Chrissy will provide a donation jar for PonyBird collections to be placed on the piano at the entry. This will be updated to reflect the respective mission as it changes. Local families in need may be added as a special Sunday School Mission when/if needed.

Canned Food Drive: 400 canned food items were collected or bought with donations. \$200 went to Brenden's Backpack plus additional food items. Note: Aldi's and Amazon Wish List are both places this mission uses for purchasing items. Remaining food items went to Jefferson County Rescue Mission.

Old Business: The Christmas bad distribution was disappointing. There were only three families that visited the drive-through setup on December 20, 2020. The food collected from the Food Drive was distributed by Sherry Pippin along with some monetary donations. Rescue Mission and Brenden's Back Pack will each get half of the food collected. The monetary collections will also be split in half but the money for Rescue Mission will be used to purchase food items to donate and the other half will be given to Brenden's Back Pack as a monetary donation.

Sunday School Classrooms: Sherry will contact Terry Kohler to see if he is interested / willing to paint the three upstairs classrooms. Adding Choir and Quilting rooms will be considered.
