

Highlight; from \$eptember 2021

Sunday School: Classes resumed September 12th. Class will be held from 10am – 10:45am following Worship Service. Opening will resume in Fellowship Hall. Attendance charts will be posted on each classroom door and teachers will mark students absent or present.

St. Luke's Youth Hope Squad: The 4th – 7th grade students have formed a youth group Their hope is to put help into action for our local community and church. We encourage everyone to drop by the class across from the bridal room for an update on their current mission. Chris Kraus will provide information regarding activities outside the normal class to both parents and the Church Council for approval.

Voyagers / Youth Group: Cindy Burke attended the BOCE's meeting to discuss Youth Ministry. Suggestions made to suit St. Luke's and youth were to involve parents and community, post pictures on social media platforms (safely and with permission), develop email or texts groups, plan activities and events that will spark interest amongst kids, build relationships with students and develop mentor program, consider missions both local and out of town. VBS: VBS spending was projected at roughly \$1100 (note: not all spending was recorded from donations). Of this total, \$250 was turned in for reimbursement and the remaining total was donated. There were fifty kids and 36 adults in attendance throughout the week.

Teacher Appreciation/ Rally Day/All Church Picnic: There were approximately eighty people in attendance. BOCE was responsible for the outdoor games and prizes, as well as purchasing food. The menu was fried chicken, green beans, mac-n-cheese that was purchased from Karsch's. Potato salad, individual bags of chips and desserts were from Sam's and donated by church members. Church Council managed the indoor games and prizes and some of them were moved outdoors that day. Board of Elders served food inside following worship and cleaned up. Canned soda, capri suns and water was purchased and iced in coolers. There was minimum seating provided for indoors and a tent was setup outside for additional seating. The Fire Department declined attending due to COVID restrictions.


