

# **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

Dear St. Luke's Family & Friends,

Easter is early this year, so as you receive your February church newsletter we are less than two weeks away from Ash Wednesday and the beginning of the Lenten season. There are several special worship and devotional opportunities during February and moving into March.

**Transfiguration Sunday, February 11** – Make plans to worship with us the final Sunday before Lent, which is Transfiguration Sunday. This traditional day in the Christian liturgical calendar includes the retelling of the account of Jesus, Peter, James, and John traveling up a mountain and the disciples observing Jesus' transfiguration, in preparation of their journey turning toward Jerusalem and the cross.

**Ash Wednesday, February 14** – Come worship with us for a solemn service marking the beginning of the Lenten journey. We will share Holy Communion during this special service which begins at 7:00pm.

**Daily Lenten Devotionals, Starting February 15** – On each Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday morning during Lent, I will be sharing a daily reflection on a scripture or theme of the day by video on Facebook. **Lenten Sermon Series, Starting February 18** – My 2024 Lenten Sermon Series is called Covenant and will trace the history of our covenant relationship with God through scripture. I hope you'll plan to join us for each Sunday morning worship time during the season.

**Lenten Lunch, March 7** – Finally, I'm looking forward to a tradition being reborn this Spring. Our Women's Circle is sponsoring a Lenten Lunch on Thursday, March 7, in Fellowship Hall at 11:00am. # Reports

Church Council minutes will be reviewed next month as they were not available at the meeting. The Treasurer's report was accepted as given.

Financial secretary's report was accepted as given.

Board of Christian Education report - Greg McLard will get the swing set ordered. Kathy Porter will speak with the members of BOCE to see if we can move Promotion Sunday to another day so it does not coincide with confirmation Sunday. Palm Sunday will be the Easter breakfast after service and also the Women's Guild will have a bake sale. When there is a mission project, please let David Pippin know so he can get the checks issued to the correct mission.

The Board of Elders report was given. Ash Wednesday service will be at 7:00 pm. There will be a Good Friday service. Not sure if it will be a Tenebrae service or just a regular service. December showed that we had 39 visitors in church. There will be a food collection from February 4th through March 31, 2024. Sausage dinner service will be at 10:00 am. The Board of Elders has requested 2 more hearing devices for the sanctuary.

Building and grounds report – the paddle fan above the choir has been replaced. Roth rooter was at the parsonage to clear the line of clogs. The organ chimes will be repaired 1/24/2024. Cemetery report was accepted as given.

Endowment report was accepted as given.

Pastors report – Ash Wednesday is 2/14/2024. The confirmand's will participate in the Lenten services. Pastor Hill will post devotionals on Facebook on Wednesday's and Thursday's. The spring bible study will be on Thursday evenings at 6:30 pm. Pastor Hill has a QR code on his business card that will take you to the church website. Pastor Hill will be participating in a pastors meeting on Thursday. This will be with other Jefferson County Pastors.

There was a request for building usage by Chrissy Kraus for Saturday 3/16/2024. Garry Kraus made a motion to approve said usage. Gary Hartmann seconded. All were in favor, motion carried.

There were no membership changes for the month but Reverend Hill did say that we will soon have baptisms to perform.
