

Goodies with Grands - 9/11/22 results: it was a great success with approximately 50-60 in attendance. Children and their Grandparents enjoyed classroom activities and goodies! Thanks to all who attended!

2nd quarter mission- Crisis Nursery sent an awesome card which breaks down your donated dollars as follows: \$100 provides formula for 160 hungry babies; \$200 allows them to feed, keep safe overnight and provide basic medical care for 2 children; \$500 helps keep 5 families from homelessness; \$1000 equips the staff with tools and supplies to provide art therapy to children who have experienced trauma; \$5000 invests in the growing Latino Outreach program.
