

At 6:40 pm, Warren Stuckmeyer called the meeting to order. Don Dankel said the opening prayer.

#### **REPORTS**

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> Pastor was not present, but Warren reported that Pastor wanted to point out upcoming dates in the church.

Building & Grounds Report: Parsonage roof has been repaired.

<u>Cemetery Report:</u> Will need to look at various trees throughout the cemetery for trimming. <u>Endowment Report:</u> The wrong dollar amount was recorded last month, there is \$4,685.64 to be dispersed from 2019-2023.

Gary Hartmann made a motion to approve all reports as presented. Jess McLard seconded. All were in favor, motion carried.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

- 1. Insurance renewal for the first quarter was paid out.
- 2. Glaus building usage of 3/29/25 is canceled, no longer needed.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- 1. Council would like to move \$60,000 from General Fund checking/savings to UCF Cash Fund to earn more interest. Money can be accessed in 3-5 days, if needed. Dave Pippin made a motion to approve the move of funds. Dane Kraus seconded. All were in favor, motion carried.
- 2. Council needs to check into AED machine maintenance. Warren will follow up with Stephanie and Bob Schrepel on when this needs to be taken care of and what is ordered.
- 3. Priority/Maintenance list is being reviewed and will be published in a future Beacon.
- 4. Discussion about Easter lilies (and any future plant memorials) and accounting concerns. Will follow up with Women's Circle for future procedures.
- 5. Discussion about a potential meal before Ash Wednesday service. Various groups could sponsor/prepare each year on a rotating basis. This will be discussed closer to the next Lenten season.


