

This week we enter one of my favorite times of the year. The word Lent simply means "Spring," but for Christian faith communities, Lent sets apart a time of preparation for Holy Week and Easter to come. Yesterday, as I shared on the Transfiguration mountaintop experience in worship, we looked toward Lent and what this time might mean for us both communally and individually. I hope you are ready to watch, listen, follow, and pray with me on this journey toward the cross once more.

We begin with Ash Wednesday this week, at 7:00pm on March 5th. We will gather for a time of contemplative worship as we consider our own mortality once more. Remember, everyone is invited to my Wednesday morning bible study during this season, too, as we explore the highs and lows of the kingship of David from 2 Samuel each Wednesday at 11:00am. Also, for all those who have signed up, we will travel to St. Martin United Church of Christ in High Ridge on Thursday, March 13th, for our annual Lenten Luncheon among the UCC churches of Jefferson County.

Finally, I begin my Lenten sermon series this coming Sunday, March 9th. I'm calling this series "The Journey" as we move through the gospel passages toward Jerusalem and the cross. Here is preview of what is to come:


