## **MATTHEW 28:1-20**

## MARK 16:1-8 [9-20]

## **LUKE 24:1-53**

- **28:1** Time: day after worship, as the sun rose Sunday morning
- Who: Mary from Magdala and the other Mary
- **28:2-8** Prelude to resurrection appearance #1
- **28:2** an earthquake occurs and an angel appears
- **28:5** the angel speaks to the women
- **28:9-10** Jesus' 1<sup>st</sup> resurrection appearance to the women
- **28:11-15** Chief priests and guards plan the cover up
- **28:16-20** Jesus' 2<sup>nd</sup> resurrection appearance where: the mountain in Galilee who: the 11 disciples
- 28:19 the great commission

**16:1** Time: when the day of worship was over, on Sunday, very early Who: Mary of Magdala, Mary the mother

Who: Mary of Magdala, Mary the mother of James, and Salome

- **16:2-8** Discovery of empty tomb
- **16:3-4** Women worry who will roll away the stone
- **16:5-7** Women encounter a young man who tells them Jesus is alive and to tell the disciples to go to Galilee
- **16:8** Women run away shocked and trembling. They did not tell anyone

\*\*\*\* Some manuscripts and translations end here. Others add verses 9-20

- 16:9-11 Jesus appears to Mary of Magdala
- **16:12-13** Jesus appears to two disciples walking home
- **16:14-18** still later, Jesus appeared to the 11 apostles while they were eating
- 16:19 Jesus ascends to heaven
- **16:20** The disciples spread the Good News

- **21:1** Time: very early on Sunday morning who: the women
- **21:2-3** the women discover the empty tomb
- **21:4-8** two men in clothes as bright as lightning appeared and told the women that Jesus is alive
- **21:9-12** The women report to the 11 apostles and all the others
- 21:10 women identified as Mary from Magdala, Joanna, Mary, the mother of James, and other women
- **21:12** Peter runs to the tomb, discovers it is empty
- **21:13-35** The road to Emmaus
- **21:15** Jesus approaches 2 disciples but is unrecognized
- 21:18 one disciple identified as Cleopas
- **21:25-27** Jesus opens the scriptures to them
- **21:30-31** Jesus is made known in the breaking of bread, and vanishes
- **21:36-49** Jesus' 2<sup>nd</sup> resurrection appearance

where: back in Jerusalem who: the 11 apostles who were gathered, the two from the road to Emmaus

21:50-51 Jesus ascends to heaven21:52-53 disciples return to the temple and praise God
