<u>Today's Reading</u>

Mark Chapter 10

Jesus is now back out in the wilderness where we get uncomfortable teachings. Remember that the wilderness symbolizes a learning environment. Here Jesus has a lot to say about divorce, how we welcome children and gets us thinking about our attitudes towards money. Jesus talks about the great reversal where the first will be last and the last will be first. Then he speaks a third time about his upcoming death and resurrection. The disciples are still pretty clueless about what Jesus has to say as James and John request the honor of sitting at Jesus right and left in his coming kingdom. This does not make the other disciples happy and Jesus uses this as a teaching moment to say that the greatest in his kingdom is a servant to all. Then they head to Jericho, where Jesus heals blind Bartimaeus, who then also starts to follow Jesus.

Jesus says clearly in this chapter that divorce is wrong. Why do you think most Christian churches permit divorce today, but struggle with welcoming those who are LGBTQIA+, which Jesus says nothing about?
