Matthew Chapter 17

Do you ever just read a story in the Gospel and wonder—What just happened there? Here chapter 17 ends with this strange story, Jesus tells Peter to go catch a fish, and in that fish will be a coin, and Peter is to take that coin to pay the tax. But the story ends there. It does not tell us if Peter actually went out and caught a fish. It does not give us Peter's reaction to finding a coin in a random fish. It doesn't tell us if the others went with him and watched to see if what Jesus said would come true. How could Jesus know that Peter would catch a random fish with a coin in its mouth. Perhaps the Gospel writer leaves the mystery so we can focus on another part of the story.
