Today's Reading

Matthew Chapter 24

Chapter 24 and 25 follow from the disciples wondering what we all wonder—when will these things happen? The disciples are asking as Jesus just said the Temple will be destroyed. We ask as we are wondering when Jesus will return. For as long as these words have been committed to paper, people have wondered. Though as we read what is about to happen, we might want to ask—Jesus, can you delay this for as long as possible? Because it sounds gruesome. And indeed, when Jerusalem fell in the year 70 AD, it was gruesome. The soldiers marched in, killed indiscriminately, burned what could be burnt, smashed what couldn't be burnt. They brought in statues of their pantheon of Gods and placed it where the Temple stood, the desolat-ing sacrilege Jesus spoke of.
