12:20-50 Greeks come to visit Jesus

12:20-22 Introduction

Reason Greeks in Jerusalem: to worship during the Passover They went to: Philip, who went to Andrew, who went to Jesus Were they received?: unclear

12:23-26 Jesus begins teaching

- 23: Time has come for Son of Man to be glorified
- 24: A single grain of wheat doesn't produce anything unless it is planted in the ground and dies
- 25: Those who love their lives will destroy them
- 26: Those who serve me must follow me
- 12:27-30 A voice from heaven
 - 27: Jesus is deeply troubled
 - 28: Jesus requests, "Father, give glory to your name." Voice from heaven said, "I have given it glory, and I will give it glory again."
 - 29: crowd heard the voice, some heard thunder, others heard an angel
- **12:31-33** The world is being judged right now
- 12:34-36a Who is the Son of Man
 - 34: crowd asks the question, Who is this Son of Man?
 - 35: Jesus compares the Son of Man to light
- **12:36b** Jesus, concealed, departs (though from where is unclear)

12:37-44 Gospel writer's narrative

- 38-41 Isaiah's prophecies of unbelief fulfilled
- 42-44 many rulers believed in Jesus

12:45-50 Jesus' dissertation on belief
