Mark Chapter 13

This chapter is often called "the little apocalypse". Here Jesus reveals events that would happen in the future. The destruction of the Temple, persecution of God's people and the coming of the Son of Man. These events were experienced by Mark's readers and also by other Christians throughout history. Jesus warns against thinking either that the end is coming very soon or at some very distant time. Jesus instructs us to learn from the fig tree and be watchful. Those who fail to keep awake will miss out on the coming kingdom.
