

**A Parallel Gospel Overview of Jesus' Entry to Jerusalem**  
**Also known as Palm Sunday**

**MATTHEW 21:1-17**

**20:29-34** Jesus was previously in Jericho, where he healed 2 Blind men

**21:1** Jesus departs from the Mount of Olives near Bethphage

**21:2, 7** Jesus rides in on a donkey and a colt

**21:4-5** Prophet's words fulfilled: Isaiah 62:11, Zechariah 9:9

**21:7-8** Coats and branches from trees are spread on roadway before Jesus

**21: 9** Crowd is shouting: Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!" - Psalm 118:26

**21:10-11** People ask as Jesus Enters:, "Who is this?" Crowd responds, "This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth in Galilee."

**21:12-13** Jesus enters Temple Courtyard and throws out those buying and selling. Jesus quotes Isaiah 56:7, Jeremiah 7:11

**21:14** Jesus heals the blind and the lame

**21: 15-16** Chief priests and scribes question Jesus, Jesus answers

**21:16** Jesus quotes Psalm 8:2

**21:17** Jesus departs Jerusalem goes to Bethany to spend the night

**MARK 11:1-11**

**10:46-52** Jesus was previously in Jericho, where he heals the blind beggar, Bartimaeus

**11:1** Jesus departs from the Mount of Olives near Bethphage and Bethany

**11:2, 7** Jesus rides in on a donkey

**11:7-8** Coats and leafy branches are spread on roadway before Jesus

**11:9-10** Crowd is shouting: "Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the coming kingdom of our ancestor David! Hosanna in the highest heaven!" – Psalm 118:26

**11: 11** Jesus Enters Temple Courtyard and looks around at everything. Then, Jesus departs with the 12 apostles to Bethany

**LUKE 19:29-46**

**19:1-28** Jesus previously in Jericho with Zacchaeus

**19:29** Jesus departs from near Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives

**19:32, 35** Jesus rides in on a donkey

**19:36** coats are spread on the roadway before Jesus

**19:38** Crowd is shouting: "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven, and glory in the highest heaven." – Psalm 118:26, Zechariah 9:9

**19:41-44** As Jesus approaches Jerusalem, he cries over and prophecies against Jerusalem

**19:45-46** Jesus enters the Temple Courtyard and throws out those who were buying and selling. Jesus quotes scripture: "Isaiah 56:7, Jeremiah 7:11

It is not recorded that Jesus departed from Jerusalem after he entered.

**JOHN 12:13-19**

**12:1-12** Jesus is previously at Martha, Mary and Lazarus' home in Bethany where during a meal, Mary anointed Jesus' feet.

It is not recorded from where Jesus departed for his entry for Jerusalem

**12:13** The Crowd during procession:had with them palm branches as they went to meet him and they were shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord, the king of Israel!"—Psalm 118:26

**12:14** Jesus rode in on a donkey

**12:15** Scripture fulfilled: Zechariah 9:9

**12:16** Disciples figure out the prophecies of Jesus entry

**12:17-18** The people of the crowd witness and testify to Jesus and reports of Jesus raising Lazarus bring more people out

**12:19** Pharisees are dumbfounded as usual
