Today's Reading

Mark Chapter 12

In this chapter, Jesus continues to agitate the religious leaders with his teachings. He tells them quite blatantly the parable of the Wicked Tenants, which infuriates the leaders when they realize it is a parable against them. The leaders then try to trick him by asking a question about paying taxes and Jesus' response utterly amazes them. Jesus is then questioned about the resurrection by the Sadducees and then a scribe asks Jesus about which commandment is the first of all. Jesus makes clear the Davidic role of the messiah and then denounces the scribes, which of course don't make them very happy. This chapter ends with a lesson on stewardship with the example of a widow's offering.
