Matthew Chapter 16

But then he says to his disciples they are to pick up their cross. They would have been familiar with the cross. They would have understood that to be executed on a cross meant they were traitors. And now they are wondering why Jesus would tell them to be traitors against the empire — what is this faith he is teaching them?
