Matthew Chapter 2

Matthew and Luke are the only Gospels that tell the story of Jesus' birth. Both stories are very different. Here we have wise men from a far away land, here we have the political intrigue of Herod's jealousy, here we have the prophets all coming true—he would be born in Bethlehem, he would come from Egypt, a lament would be heard, and he would be called a Nazorean. That is a lot of prophecies to all of a sudden come true all at once. Perhaps, Matthew was orchestrating his story in such a way to help his reader understand how God had been working through all of these tragic events, to give comfort even in a time when the reader is dealing with tragic events.



Start the Thinking
