Matthew Chapter 9

Remember how at the end of Matthew Chapter 7, it was said the crowds were amazed because Jesus taught like one with authority, not like the scribes? Chapter 9 is a continuation of Chapter 8's demonstration of Jesus' authority. But now the more Jesus acts, the more the word about Jesus spreads. He heals a paralytic, and the crowds are in awe. He eats with tax collectors and sinners, and the Pharisees take note. He heals a rabbi's daughter and word spreads. He tells two healed blind men not to tell, and they go running and telling people about it. The world is full of pain. And Jesus is just one, and he is the Christ, the anointed one, but he is still just one. More must be a part of bringing the kingdom of God to fullness.
