Since the authorities have very strict ways of understanding how God works, and Jesus does not stay within those strict limits, the authorities are at a loss about how to handle this. Their power and authority comes from maintaining their strict ways of understanding God. They are not free enough to see that God is not contained to our human limits, but that God works to bring glory in ways that free us from our strict interpretations.
