John Chapter 16

I get a kick out of Jesus in verses 5 and following. He says to the disciples, "But now I am going to him who sent me; yet none of you asks me, 'Where are you going?" And it's like, well, duh, Jesus, you haven't taken a breath between sentences all evening, when are they supposed to ask this question. Also, Jesus, you have confused these poor disciples so much, they don't even know what they are supposed to ask right now. Jesus is telling them he has to leave. And this remains a question in our faith today. Why couldn't Jesus avoid this death and just stay? Here in John's Gospel, Jesus is driving home a point about how salvation will happen, through him being glorified on a cross. It is unavoidable. The sins of the world are only going to be defeated in Jesus glory, a moment that comes with crucifixion and resurrection.
