Today's Reading

Mark Chapter 15

This is Jesus fate after he meets with Pilate, who then hands him over to be killed; not because he has found him guilty, but rather to prevent an angry mob. So with the help of Simon of Cyrene to carry his cross, Jesus is crucified on Golgotha. While on the cross, he was taunted by the bystanders as well as those who were crucified with him. While there are no mention of the disciples nearby, there were women who stayed, among them were Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James the younger and Joses, and Salome. They helped Joseph of Arimathea place Jesus' body in a tomb before evening when the sabbath would begin.
