<u>Today's Reading</u>

Matthew Chapter 1

Today's reading includes a passage listing the genealogy of Jesus, and a brief account of Jesus' birth. Matthew and Luke both include Jesus' genealogy and a narrative about Jesus' birth. The accounts vary, though, as each author had a different purpose for telling this story. As you read the list of Jesus' ancestors, some names are more difficult to pronounce, and that is simply due to these names being ancient Hebrew names. Matthew' includes this list, though, to help the us understand how God has woven this story of salvation through the whole of Israel's history. The birth narrative in Matthew is significantly shorter than in Luke. Matthew is interested in how ancient Hebrew prophecy is fulfilled, so he crafts his story in such a way as to demonstrate that prophecy coming true in Jesus.
