We will discuss ideas of how to use the Vision and Purpose giving in November to support our food pantry.

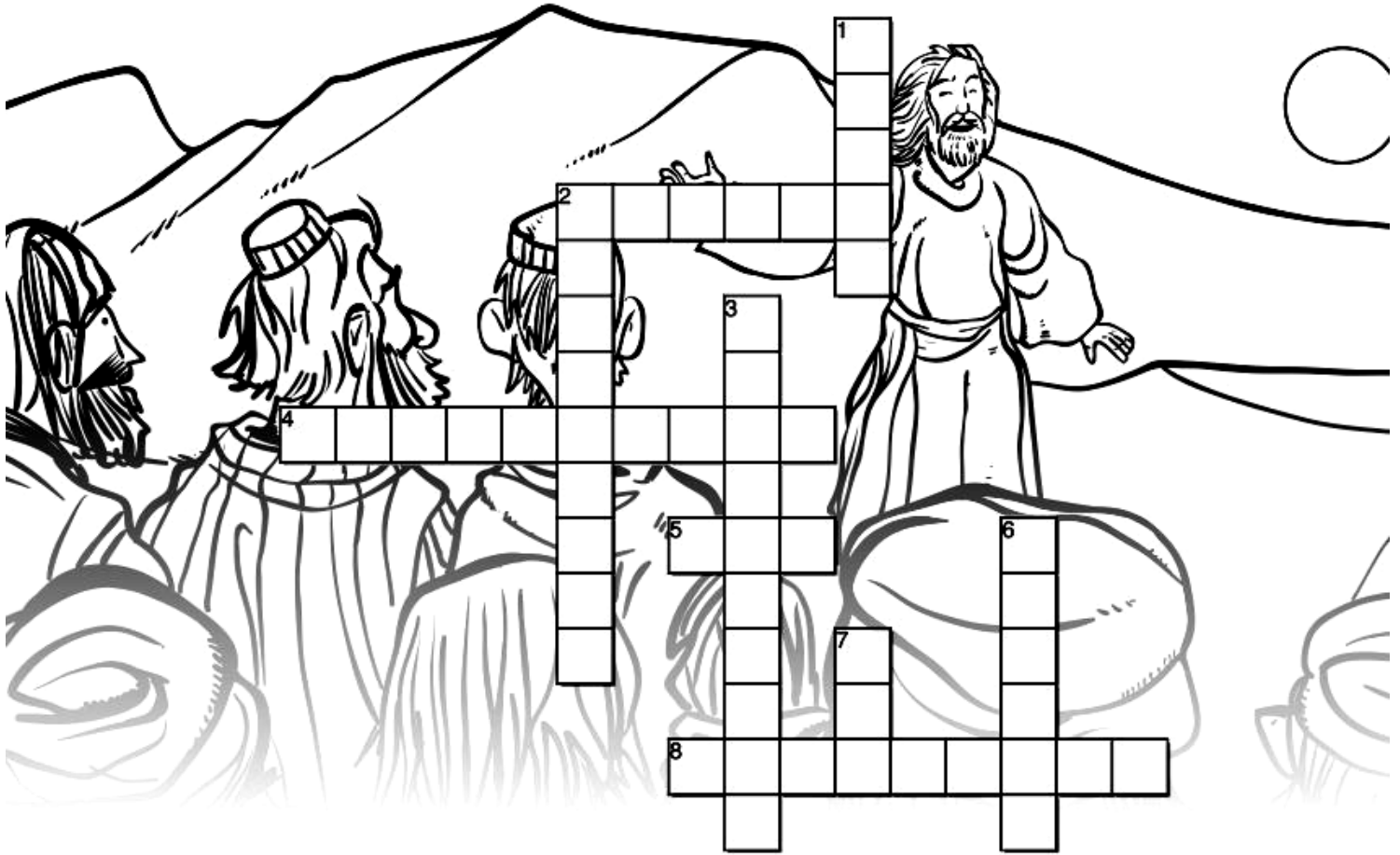
## Matthew 14:13-21
