MY TIPS AND TRICKS

- Create a Level Sleeping Surface: Fold down or remove any seats to create a flat surface in your SUV. If needed use a foam mattress or an inflatable pad to provide a great night's sleep compared to sleeping bags alone, especially in the gaps between the seats.
- Window Covers for Privacy: Use reflective material or blackout curtains cut to fit your car windows or you can grab some on Amazon (Link Below). These block light, provide privacy and help regulate the temperature inside the car.
- Use a Tent Attachment for Extra Room: A tent attachment that connects to the back of your SUV adds extra space for gear, allows better ventilation, and gives you more room for relaxing outside the car.
- Bring a Car Battery Booster: While car camping sometimes a light is left on or the battery will die because of a door being open. The last thing you want is to be stuck so I always pack a self jumper.
