### LOCALLY:

2. To establish New Level Church California (NLCCA) main worship center at Los Angeles County, California. This is also called New Level Church United States (NLCUS), the NLC main office in the United States that will soon oversees NLC worship centers through out the continents of Northern America, Southern America, and Europe. *(Fulfilled on 2016)*

3. To establish a church building with an accredited bible university campus at NLCCA. This will serve as the Apostolic Center of NLC, where the "Five E's of Discipleship" will be initiated, developed and implemented. *(Fulfilled on 2017)*

4. To evangelize to the communities and neighboring cities, seeking for Spirit-filled disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ. *(Being fulfilled since 2018)*

5. To intensify the discipleship mentoring, workshop, and seminars at NLCCA, making disciples and disciple-makers, preparing the future leaders of NLC. *(Being fulfilled since 2018)*

6. To support other struggling Full Gospel, Christ-centered, Bible-based and Spirit-filled ministries and ministers of the Gospel, through NLC Apostolic Ministry. *(Being fulfilled since 2019)*

7. To launch Hispanic/Tagalog worship service at NLCCA main worship center. *(To be fulfilled on 2023)*

8. To plant NLC worship centers through out California such as New Level Church San Fernando Valley (NLCCA-SFV) *(Fulfilled on 2016)*, New Level Church Santa Clarita Valley (NLCCA-SCV) *(Fulfilled on 2019)*, New Level Church Downtown Los Angeles (NLCCA-DLA), New Level Church San Gabriel Valley (NLCCA-SGV), etc.

9. After the NLCCA/NLCUS is established, to plant NLC worship centers in other States (i.e. New Level Church Florida or NLCFL, New Level Church Nevada or NLCNV, etc.).

10. NLCCA/NLCUS to support physically and spiritually the pastors and leaders of other NLC worship centers until they can stand on their own fulfilling the vision and mission of NLC.

### GLOBALLY:

11. To establish New Level Church Philippines (NLCPH) main worship center *(Fulfilled on 2022)*. This will be the NLC main office in the Philippines that will soon oversees NLC worship centers through out the provinces in the Philippines, as well as the continents of Asia, Africa, and Australia.

### GENERAL:

12. For each NLC worship center, to establish Fivefold Ministry Teams (Ephesians 4:11) and other ministries as needed. Also, to establish "Life Group Bible Study" outreaches to meet regularly.

## Established Objectives:

### ENCOUNTER: (Matthew 22:37-38)

- To be in line with Jesus Ministry, and Scripture.
- To care for the needs of all in spirit, soul, and body.

### EVANGELIZE: (Acts 1:8)

- To share the Gospel and the love of Christ to all.
- To reach all in God's ways, will, statutes, and ordinances so that all can receive the promises of His Word.

### ESTABLISH: (Matthew 7:24-27)

- To be transformed by God's Word and by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- To work as one body, communicating with one another to accomplish His will.

### EQUIP: (Ephesians 4:11-12)

- To build each member of the body in their purpose and calling, so each can fulfill the Great Commission and walk in God's blessing.
- To speak prophetic words of life into all, and seek God's will for everyone that God sends.

### EMPOWER: (Matthew 28:19-20)

- To duplicate the efforts establishing Jesus' ministries in all parts of the globe.
- To promote Jesus, His ministry, and the Body of Christ. **IT'S ALL ABOUT JESUS!**

### OTHERS:

11. To raise Spirit-filled and actively involved worshipping congregation of at least 120 to 300 people (Acts 1:14 - 26) for each NLC worship center.

12. To raise the amount of at least \$60,000 annual operation budget (\$5,000 monthly) for each NLC worship center. (This budget is applicable in the United States only. See "Budget" for more details.)

## Programs:

### NLC THEME OF THE YEAR: #KairosSeason2023

1. Prophetic Worship – The Scripture says, "God is Spirit, and His worshippers must worship in the Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:24) As a "Spirit-sensitive" church, our utmost desire is to encounter the Lord and to experience His manifest presence. We value the significance and importance of Spirit-led (Christ-centered and Bible-based) expressions.

2. Evangelism - Going into all the world and "preach the Gospel to all creation." (Mark 16:15) Evangelism efforts that in line with community outreach, marketplace ministry, school campus ministry, feeding programs, music tutorials, street evangelism, and all other opportunities to share the Good News to others. The goal of evangelism efforts is simple: To convert the nonbelievers to become Christian believers (John 3:16; Romans 10:14-15; 1 Timothy 2:4).
