RULES OF THE COURSE

General

The Race Card will be 8 races with 8 horses in each race:

The winning horse will receive prize money which will be a percentage of that taken for the sale of horses. If the horse is not taken, then prize money will be paid into a general fund.

The Tote will pay out a percentage of the total taken for that Race.

After the fourth race there will be a break for refreshments. A light supper is available by virtue of your £5.00 entrance fee.

The bar will be open from 7.00pm for the duration of the horse racing.

Race Sponsorship

We invite Individuals, Companies, Lodges or Organisations to sponsor races at £20 per race. The sponsors name etc will be shown in the Race Card and have a short introduction when the Race is announced.

Horse Ownership

You can purchase horses for Races 1-7 prior to the Event at £5 per horse. If your horse wins, then prize money will be paid. This will enable those who are unable to attend the Races to own a horse and for others to get in early. We would hope to be able to sell all the horses for the first 7 races prior to the evening.

If a horse is not purchased before the race, then it will be auctioned on the night and the winning bid will own the horse. If any horse is not purchased, then it will still take part in the race and prize money paid into a general fund.

Prior to the last Race (Race 8), an Auction will take place for the horses. You can also name your horse if you wish.

Tote

The list of horses, together with their owners, will be shown prior to the race and any unsold horses will be auctioned to the highest bidder. After this you will be invited to place your bets and the payout will be half the take for that race to the winning horse, distributed in proportion to the bets placed.

Minimum bet £1.

Tickets

Tickets and purchase of horses can be obtained through bloodstock agents. Horses should be selected by the race number and horse eg Race 5, Horse 4.

All Entry Tickets and Horse Purchases should be paid for at the time of booking to enable us to prepare for the night. In the event that the horse you have selected has already been taken the next available horse will be allocated. Entry Tickets will be available until Monday 9th March.

Do come along and we are sure you will have an enjoyable evening and also benefit a worthy cause.
