Another featured treat is the artisan chocolate, which is made by Swiss chocolatier Philippe Pascoët and flown in weekly from Switzerland. I'm not the biggest chocolate fan, but I decided to purchase some for the review. I got the lavender flavor, and it tasted so delicious that I may have changed my opinion on chocolate.

Paris in a Bite also has a small selection of baked goods made fresh every morning. The menu includes butter, almond and chocolate croissants and mini danishes, which range from around \$2-\$4. Savory Bites is another section of the menu, including cheese plates and mini bites such as crunchy beef taco cups, caramelized onions and feta pastries. They also have gourmet caviar available. Paris in a Bite also offers a variety of drinks, from hot chocolate to coffee. Since the shop is fairly new, they will continue to add new products and updates all the time. This is the perfect place to go after school or to go have brunch with your friends.
