Puppy Class from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, Mondays starting 6/28/2021 Puppy Class from 6:15 – 7:15 pm, Mondays starting 6/28/2021 Puppy Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Tuesdays starting 6/29/2021

Prerequisites: Dogs need to be 12-weeks to 6-months old and must have current shots.

Description: The goal of the puppy class is to help you and your new puppy get to know each other and to introduce basic obedience concepts to the puppy. A major part of this class is socialization with other people and other dogs. This is done in a class setting where concepts of attention and walking on a leash are introduced. AKC Star Puppy test is available at the end of this class.

Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by June 14th.

Puppy Plus / Manners from 7:30 – 8:30 pm, Mondays starting 6/28/2021 Puppy Plus / Manners from 7:15 – 8:15 pm, Tuesdays starting 6/29/2021 FULL

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills. For small-breed dogs up to 18-months old, and large-breeds up to 12-months old with Instructor's approval.

Description: This class is designed for further socialization of young dogs. Basic skills of heeling, recalls, sits, downs, and stays will be reinforced. Training of manners for having a well-rounded family pet will be a focus of this class. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your young dog. **Cost of class is** \$100 for six weeks! **Cost of class is** \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by **June 14th.**

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills.

Description: This class will teach the foundation skills for having a well-rounded family pet, and for competitive obedience. Attention, heeling, sits and downs, sit/wait with attention, recall games, and stays will be covered. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your dog. This class is also useful as a basis for dogs/handler planning on agility. **Cost of class is** \$100 for six weeks! **Cost of class is** \$90, **IF you register, and pre-pay by June 14**th.

Pawsitively Fun from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Tuesdays starting 6/29/2021

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II, or have equivalent skills. **Description**: Pawsitively Fun is for those who want a more well-rounded family pet, and for those considering both advanced training and competition. The course is designed to develop your dog's confidence both at home, and in social settings. Practice and refine the skills learned in Foundations of Obedience I & II, while applying them to games in a social setting, with other dogs and owners. Each one-hour session is filled with games, challenges, obstacles, and fun! Class size limited to *eight* handler & dog teams. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by June 14th.**

Foundations of Obedience II Class from 6:15 – 7:15 pm, Wednesdays starting 6/30/2021 Foundations of Obedience II Class from 6:00 – 7:00 pm, Thursdays starting 7/01/2021

Prerequisites: Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have equivalent skills. **Description:** Behaviors such as stay, coming when called, walking on-leash & off-leash, are practiced with distractions using creative, fun games and exercises. Teaching your dog to focus on you when the environment gets busy is essential to a happy life with your dog. This class provides excellent preparation for trainers interested in dog sports: agility, competition obedience, and rally obedience. The AKC Canine Good Citizen Exam will be available after this class. **Cost of class is \$100 for six weeks! Cost of class is \$90, IF you register, and pre-pay by June 14th.** No Thursday Class July 8th, and July 29th, these will be made-up.

Beginners Scent Work Fun from 5:00 – 6:00 pm, Wednesdays starting 6/30/2021
