Pothole season

Potholes are created when snow and ice melt as part of Michigan's seasonal freeze-thaw cycles. Moisture seeps into the pavement, freezes, expands and thaws, creating a gap in the pavement. As vehicles drive over the gap, the pavement weakens leading to a pothole. A new website launched by the Michigan Association for Justice aims to be a one stop shop for pothole weary motorists. Included is a petition to the state Legislators, and a link to an MDOT form for damage claims up to \$1000.

The problem with that idea is you must prove the State knew the pothole was there and did not fix it within 30 days. For more information go to

The city has announced that storm debris cleanup will commence March 31st. Work crews will be deployed simultaneously in multiple locations across the city and will follow the city's established plow routes (Churchill Downs is in plow route 23). Citizens are also asked to limit on-street parking in active cleanup areas. Work crews will be using heavy equipment and large trucks to remove debris. Cars parked on the street may interfere with curbside cleanup operations.

Citizens can also drop off storm debris at Washington Park, located at 2700 S. Washington Avenue. A map showing details of the debris drop-off location is available online at lansingmi.gov/debris. The drop-off location will be open from dawn to dusk.

The city has placed all ice storm debris collection information online at <u>lansingmi.gov/debris</u>. Please also do not hesitate to contact the Public Service Department at (517) 483-4161.

If you live in a CDBG-eligible area (see the CDBG map at lansingmi.gov/debris) and need assistance removing storm debris from your yard, please call 483-4071 or email icestorm2013@lansingmi.gov. Please provide your name, address and a telephone number or email address where you can be contacted. The deadline for including an address within the CDBG-eligible area is Monday, April 21, 2014 at 5:00 pm EST. A liability waiver from the property owner will be required for the work crew to enter the property.


