Moto Recovery is a nonprofit, rider-led mutual aid organization based in Colorado Springs, Colorado. Built by motorcyclists, for motorcyclists, our mission is to strengthen the riding community through safety, education, and rider support.

We focus first on motorcycle safety and education by providing scholarships for riders pursuing their motorcycle endorsement, refresher training, and continued rider education. Better-trained riders create safer roads and a stronger riding community.

As part of our mutual aid mission, Moto Recovery coordinates volunteer, rider-to-rider assistance when a motorcyclist is stranded or in need. This support is offered when circumstances allow and is not a commercial service. Moto Recovery does not operate as a towing or for-hire transport company.

Moto Recovery operates entirely through community support. There are no required fees for assistance. Riders who choose to contribute after receiving help may do so voluntarily to support ongoing operations, volunteer efforts, and rider education scholarships.

When you support Moto Recovery, you are not paying for a tow. You are investing in safer riders, stronger community connections, and a culture of riders looking out for one another.
