

# Moto Recovery Governance Summary

Moto Recovery, Inc. is a Colorado-based 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to motorcycle safety, education, and charitable rider assistance.

## **Leadership Structure**

Moto Recovery is led by an Executive Director who oversees operations, compliance, and mission execution. Officer roles (President, Secretary, Treasurer) support governance and administration.

## **Officer Selection**

Officers may be elected from the membership or appointed by the Executive Director. Elections occur every two years, with nominations in October, elections in November, and terms beginning in January of even-numbered years.

## **Committees**

Committees may be formed as needed to support education, scholarships, fundraising, and community outreach.

## **Compensation**

The Executive Director may receive a reasonable monthly stipend, capped at 10–15% of gross receipts, in compliance with IRS guidelines.

## **Membership**

Members include donor-tier supporters, Annual Rider Support Program participants, and individuals appointed by corporate sponsors.

## **Dissolution**

If Moto Recovery dissolves, all assets will be distributed to similar charitable nonprofit organizations.
