## Financial Responsibility Policy

Moto Recovery is committed to responsible financial stewardship, transparency, and accountability in all organizational operations. - The Treasurer maintains accurate financial records, including tracking of income, expenses, and restricted funds when applicable.
- The Board of Directors reviews financial activity regularly to ensure oversight and responsible fiscal management.
- Organizational expenses must support Moto Recovery's mission, including rider assistance, education scholarships, program development, and operational sustainability.
- Any stipends or reimbursements must be approved in accordance with board authorization and documented appropriately.
- Moto Recovery does not distribute profits to individuals and operates exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.
