The Financial Report by Mary Madden

We have slightly over \$31,600 in the bank. Approximately 70 families have paid their dues. For all of 2019 approximately 100 families paid dues. Most of the association expenses are in the second half of the calendar year.

Mountain Patrol Representative

He cautioned those walking on the paved road to be on the lookout for rattlesnakes.

He urged those with Kayaks to put some identification on the kayak so that the kayak can be returned if it floats away.

He also noted that there was a problem with some jet skis going too fast.

Ethan Franklin of the Department of Natural Resources

Ethan left a booklet of boating rules. He emphasized that children under 13 must wear a life jacket. Certain classes of boats should have a throwable, either a ring or a cushion with two straps. The no wake rules are not enforceable unless they are on official (government) signs. Ours are not. Ethan's group is stretched covering the three lakes and the gorge, although the next day he was going to Lanier. Seed Lake is calm compared to the other lakes.
