 If married, must be married in the Catholic faith.


Weddings

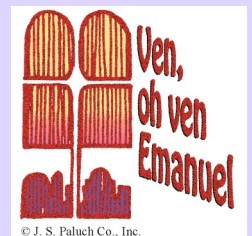

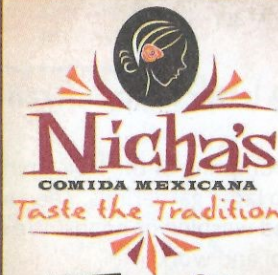
