

A CLEAN HEART

We are getting very close to the end of Lent. There are two choices for Gospels today. Whichever Gospel you hear—Jesus saying he would be lifted up on the cross (John 12:20–33) or the story of his friend Lazarus (John 11:1-45)—both psalms remind us that we need forgiveness and we can ask God's help to change our hearts. Today's two psalm responses psalms are:

Create a clean heart in me, O God. (Psalm 51:12a)
With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption. (Psalm 130:7,

If your parish has catechumens-people who will be baptized at Easterpart of their preparation is the celebration of scrutiny rites on the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent. A scrutiny is an examination or careful study. The catechumens have the opportunity in these rites to examine their lives and ask the questions, "What am I doing that is good?" and What things in my life do I need to change?" You might ask yourself the same questions. Use the letters of the word "forgiveness" to think of some actions or thoughts in your life that are good and others that need changing. Some examples are done for you. Mark good actions with a G and those you need to change
