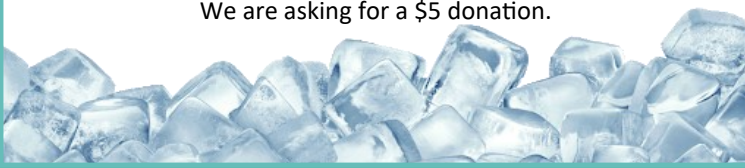

Each Gospel has its own psalm response, so listen for which story will be proclaimed and which psalm you will sing. Both psalm responses are about listening to God's words.

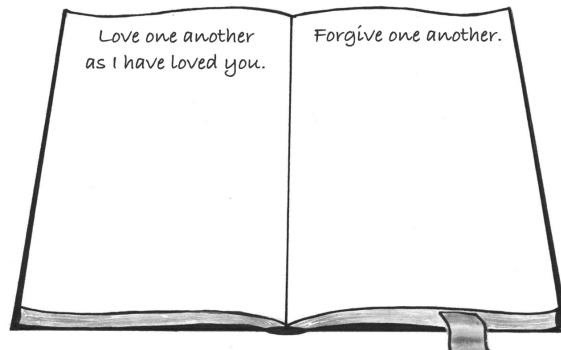
Lord, you have the words
