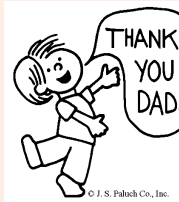

Altar flowers and Tabernacle flowers are available to dedicate to your loved ones. Each flower arrangement is \$75. Come to the office to reserve your week.



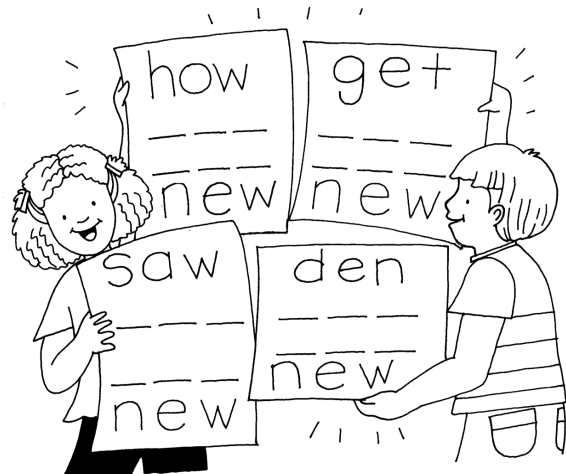
