Quinceañeras or Sweet 16's

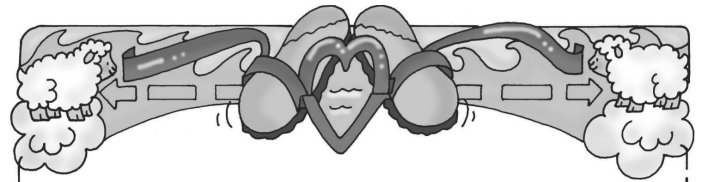
All debutantes / quinceañeras must attend religious classes / CCD at least one year prior to the celebration.

First Communion Class

Our First Communion classes for baptized children in the 2nd grade or older will begin August 29, 2021. Class is every Sunday from 9:45 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. The final class is September 26, 2021. Because there are only 5 weeks of class, children must attend class every week. First Communion masses are scheduled for Saturday, October 9, 2021 and Sunday, October 10, 2021. For students unable to attend class in August, our second session will begin Sunday, October 17, 2021. Class is every Sunday from 9:45 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. The final class is November 21, 2021. First Communion masses will be Saturday, December 4, 2021 and Sunday December 5, 2021. Registration begins the first week in August.

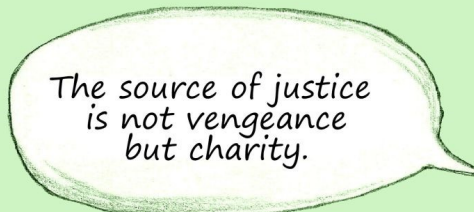
