

*Treasures of the Archdiocese of San Antonio* has been published to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the establishment of the Diocese of San Antonio.

Treasures of the Archdiocese of San Antonio is a soft-cover, 440 page, glossy 9.65 inch by 11.81 inch book that features histories and photographs of all Catholic churches in the archdiocese, as well as biographies, features on important ministries, and events highlights. The book is also available in Spanish.

*Treasures of the Archdiocese of San Antonio* begins with a foreword by Archbishop Gustavo García-Siller, MSpS, and is followed by a history of the archdiocese. Each church is featured with professional photographs which were taken exclusively for the book. Additionally, side-bar stories highlight important historical figures, institutions, and organizations which had an impact on the archdiocesan community.

The last significant history of the archdiocese was printed in 1974 in conjunction with the 100th anniversary of the establishment of the local church of San Antonio as a diocese.

"As we celebrate the sesquicentennial of the establishment of the Diocese of San Antonio and a century since the elevation of the diocese to an archdiocese, may we continue to grow in faith and holiness, in fidelity to Christ and His Church," said Archbishop Gustavo. "Looking to the future, let us build upon the strong foundations

left by all who have preceded us."
