The Nicene Creed

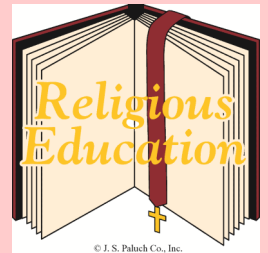
