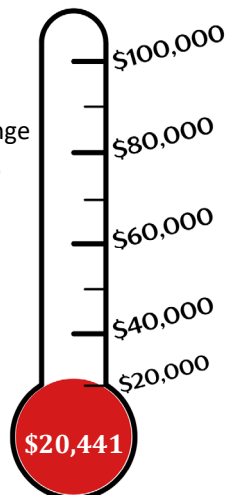
Match the Pastor Challenge

Second Annual Gabriel Project Christmas Walmart Gift Card Drive

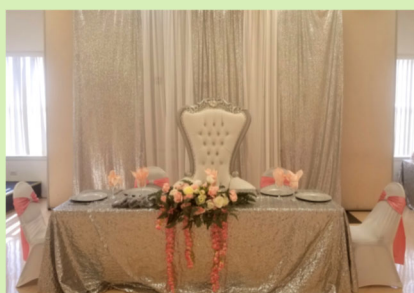
