Attention Crystal Residents: Fall 2010 Leaf Pickup

Fall is upon us and the leaves are starting to fall and the Crystal DPW is ready to help you get rid of them. Each day that the DPW picks up leaves they will follow the route outlined below, continuing where they left off on the next day of work.

We hope that this published Leaf Pick up Schedule will help you plan your fall leaf raking!

What you need to know

Crystal Township will begin to pick up leaves the week of October 11, 2010 and run through November 12, 2010 weather permitting.

Please rake leaves as close to the road edge as possible. Please be aware that if sticks, trash or anything other than leaves are found in your piles, they <u>will not</u> be picked up. You also can take your leave to the sewer plant for disposal. All Township residences can take their leaves to the sewer plant located at 3042 Miner Road (you will see the pile of leaves).

LEAF PICKUP ROUTE

Starting on the south end of town (Sidney and Crystal Road) north to Oak Street and as far west as the Lake

continuing to the

Grove and onto North Shore Drive

then

Strait Tow Blvd to South Shore Drive

the route will conclude at Duck Lake

Waterview Drive subdivision then Colby Road

on to

Shephard Drive

finishing up on

Colonel Point.

... and then we will start all over again.

The amount of time to complete any section of this route will depend on the amount of leaves and weather conditions.
